

# Distance Learning (DL) Schedule Spring 2009

## Matching up your PHS and UVSC Distance Learning Schedules

With the PHS 8 period schedule, matching up your PHS and UVSC Distant Learning schedule may be a little tricky. Here are the guidelines to follow:

1. All UVSC DL classes will cause you to **miss at least two (2) PHS classes** (the periods you would miss are noted on the right side of the chart below).
2. A few UVSC DL classes will cause you to **miss or interrupt four (4) PHS classes**. This means you will need to take two (2) UVSC DL classes to cover those periods and notify your PHS teacher of the interruption in your attendance.
3. One UVSC class is equal to two (1.0 credits) Provo High School classes.

\*English 1010 is for Seniors only. Students must have an ACT score of 19 or higher on the Reading and English sections for their test. They may qualify with a COMPASS test score of 77-Reading and 80-Writing.

\*\*English 2010 and PHIL 2050 has a pre-requisite of ENG 1010 passing with a C or better . PHIL 2050 has limited enrollment. Students must register through Mrs. Marshall only.

\*\*MATH 1050 Requires an ACT score of 24 or higher or a COMPASS test score of 70 or higher. Enrollment is through Mrs. Marshall only. Enrollment is limited in this class. Students passing MAT 1010 with a C or better also qualify.

History 2700 together with 2710 fulfill the Civics Requirement for the college. 2710 is the equivalent to the high school US History.
