**** Offered to Senior Students only, no exceptions. College Writing** requires an ACT English and Reading score of 19 or higher or a COMPASS Test score of 80 or higher on the Writing Assessment and 77 or higher on the Reading Assessment as well as a 3.0 or higher GPA in order to qualify for the college credit.

Algebra 2 requires an ACT Math score of 19 or higher, or a COMPASS Test score of 59 or higher in Algebra in order to qualify for this course.

Pre-Calculus requires an ACT Math score of 24 or higher, or a COMPASS Test score of 70 or higher in Algebra, in order to qualify for this college credit. Students needing to take the COMPASS Test need to have all test scores in to Mrs. Marshall no later than September 15, 2007.

US History with Mrs. Bledsoe requires extra reading and course work in order to receive a passing grade on their college transcript. Students seeking college credit for this class should be prepared and commit to this extra course work at the beginning of the school year before registering for this college credit.

Courses usually offered only to Junior and Senior students may allow Sophomore students with special recommendations from their counselor and Mrs. Marshall. Sophomores seeking this recommendation must meet with Mrs. Marshall prior to registration.

(Certain classes will allow a student to receive the credit they missed as Freshman, those classes are Drafting and German. The requirement is that they must be a continuing student in the program.)
